When Brother Branham was young, he played and laughed just like us. We decided to visit some of the places that were important to him when he was a kid, so you can see what it was like too.

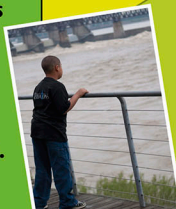

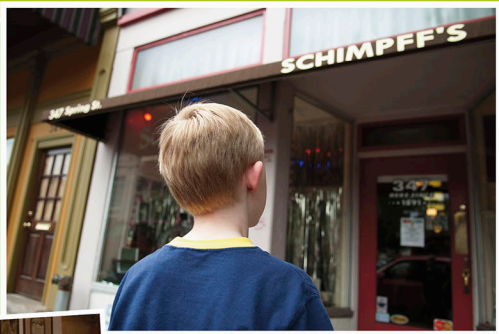
These young sisters found a couple of sea shells to take home as souvenirs.

MICAH

THE PROPHET

In the days of King Ahab, there lived a **PROPHET NAMED MICAH**. The king and his friend, Jehoshaphat, were planning a battle against the Syrians. Ahab asked his 400 prophets if they should fight this battle. All of them said "yes."

King Jehoshaphat was still a little nervous, so he asked Ahab if there was a prophet of the Lord that they could consult. Ahab answered, "there is one more, but I hate him."

THAT MAN WAS MICAH THE PROPHET, AND HE HAD THE WORD OF GOD.

When the king's messengers talked to **MICAH**, they tried to tell him what to say. They told him to tell Ahab to go into battle. But Micah knew better; he had **THE WORD OF THE LORD** and knew that Ahab would die if he fought the battle.

When they brought Micah in front of the two kings, he must have been under a lot of pressure, because

everyone there was against him. **BUT MICAH DIDN'T CARE.** When he told Ahab not to fight the Syrians, the king got so mad that he threw Micah into prison. Micah could have said sorry to King Ahab, and went along with the others, but he didn't. He would rather **DO WHAT GOD SAID.**

What do you think happened to Ahab when he ignored the messenger of the Lord?

Did God honor Ahab's 400 men? Or did God honor the Word of His prophet? You can find out by reading 1st Kings, Chapter 22.

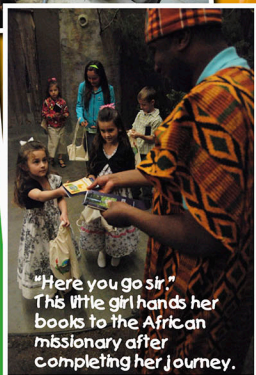

THE BRAVE PIGEON

SOMETIMES THE LITTLEST SOLDIER IS THE HERO





American soldiers were pinned down by German machine gun fire. They were trapped and had no way out and no bullets. The German soldiers were coming from everywhere, and surrounding them on all sides. The Americans knew that if they didn't get help, they would all die. Then one of the soldiers remembered they had one more chance, a little pigeon. He knew if this pigeon could fly out of there; that it could carry a message to the main headquarters for help. He was their only hope.

So they sat down and wrote on a note:

have to surrender
or we'll be killed!

The Germans saw what happened and started shooting at the pigeon. One of them hit him with a machine gun bullet and broke his leg. Another bullet hit him in the back. His chest was all bruised up. One of his wings was crippled, so he had to fly sideways. But

he kept flying,
and finally
he made it. He
was crippled,
wounded, broken,
and bruised, but
he fell into the
camp with the message
to help the trapped
soldiers.



Because the little
pigeon sacrificed its
life, the other soldiers
got help and were rescued from the Germans. They
would've died if it hadn't been for the courageous
pigeon.

When Brother Branham tells this story,
he's using it as an example of what Christ did for us
on Calvary. We were trapped in sin and being surrounded
by the devil on all sides, then God sent the Dove from
Glory to come save us. On Calvary's cross, He was
wounded, broken, beaten, and torn, but He knew
His way back Home to Heaven. Jesus rescued us
from the enemy and set us free!

So anytime you have need of something,
or you feel trapped by the devil, just
call on the Name of Jesus. He'll take
your cry for help all the way to the
Headquarters of Glory, and help will
arrive!

Shamgar looked out the window of their humble little home. As he turned back, he saw the tattered clothes on his frail wife and the hungry faces of his little children. Tears came to his eyes as he prayed out to God to give them strength and to protect them from the cruel Philistines.

His sweet wife walked up and faithfully stood by his side. Shamgar encouraged her that the Lord would watch over their family, but he didn't know what he would do if the Philistine soldiers came back to take their harvest again. He and his family would die.

Just as he was thinking about these things, he heard something coming. It was the Philistines! Six-hundred armed and trained soldiers were marching

up the road. They were coming to take everything Shamgar had worked for. His wife began to cry and the little children were holding each other and scared. Shamgar looked out the window and saw their shining armor and big spears as they walked toward his home. They were warriors, and he was only a farmer. He didn't even know how to fight, and he didn't have time to train.

Then something came over Shamgar. Brother Branham said that "he got a little fight in him."

"I'm an Israelite and a son of God. I know that I'm right and those Philistines are wrong. God promised me victory!" Shamgar didn't have anything to fight with, so he grabbed the only thing he could find, an ox-goad. He jumped out of the window and fought 600 armed Philistine soldiers and defeated every one of them.

God honored Shamgar's faith and gave him the strength and courage to fight the enemy and save his family. The only thing he had to do was to take God at His Word and believe. That's all we have to do today. If there's anything you have need of, just remember that God promised He would supply our every need if we'll only take courage like Shamgar and believe.

The Bible doesn't say much about this brave farmer, but we can learn a lot from his story. Read about Shamgar in Judges 3:31

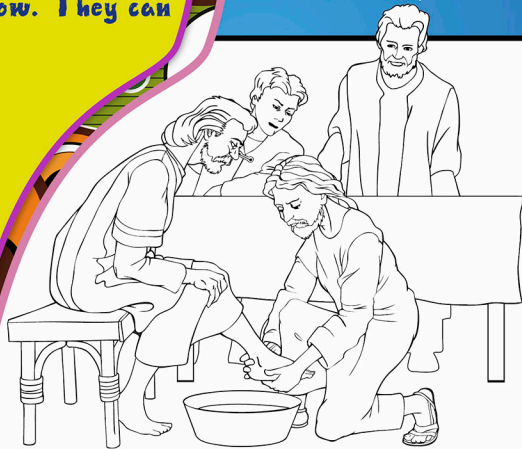

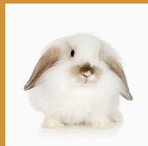
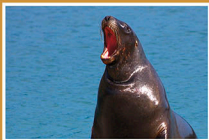

One day in Heaven, we will be able to play with lions. They will be as gentle as a lamb! Doesn't that sound like fun?



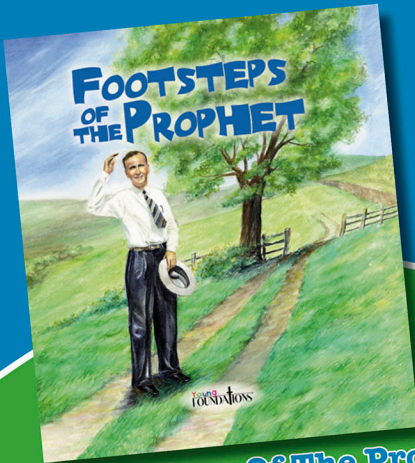
