A sacrifice is when you give up something that is important to you for something that is greater and even more important. You can make sacrifices for your family, your friends, and especially for God. You can even make sacrifices for people you don't know. Every time you send in your Jesus Jar money, you are making a sacrifice for a person you've never met before. You could have used the money for yourself and bought a new doll or a new slingshot, but you chose to give to someone else instead.

When you take time to read your Bible, pray, and listen to Brother Branham, you're sacrificing time. You could be outside playing, or doing something else. But these sacrifices can affect you or some other person forever.

THE BOOK OF ROMANS CHAPTER 12, VERSE 1

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.







When you work hard for something and then give it up to someone else, you are "sacrificing" that thing. It doesn't have to be money, or your favorite toys or clothes, but it can simply be your time, or going out of your way to do something kind for another person.






People laughed and made fun of the funny looking soldier, as he walked away with only half a cloak around his uniform. But Saint Martin didn't care. He knew he had done the right thing.


Later that night, Saint Martin was sound asleep, when all at once he heard something in his room!



We here in Young Foundations are far from experts when it comes to writing plays, but here are some of the steps we take when we write a script.





and who will be the writer. If you need to, you can do both.

Decide who will be the director.

Ask yourself. "What is the goal of this story?" Are you teaching your audience about something they've neard. or are you entertaining them with an old, familiar story?



Think of a situation (it can be a Bible story, Brother
Branham story, or just a made-up story) that helps meet
the goal of your play. Or just use one of the stories in this
magazine and make a play out of it.

If it is a Bible story, refresh your memory by reading it two or three times before you start writing. Then, search the Message for anything Brother Branham may have said about the story. Sometimes Brother Branham tells so much about a story that you hardly have to do any writing at all.

Start to write. You can get straight into the story, or use a narrator for an introduction.



Write down a list of characters and pick your actors.

Once your play is written, get your actors together and practice until everyone knows their lines.







If there are any props that need to be set up, now is the time to do it.


