Curry is a famous Indian spice. Some say if taste were a color, curry would be dark brown. You should try it, but be careful, it gets HOT!

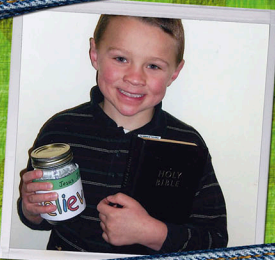
The name India is derived from the River Indus.

# KING SOLOMON

**S**olomon's story starts with his dad, King David; the same David who slew the mighty Goliath and became king of Israel.

When King David died, his son, Solomon, took over the kingdom. Solomon was worried about his new responsibilities as king. But like his dad, he turned to the Lord for help.

The Lord came to King Solomon in a dream. God told him, "Ask what I shall give thee."

The good king replied, "Give me now wisdom and knowledge, that I may go out and come in before this people: for who can judge this thy people, that is so great?"

King Solomon could have asked for riches, honor, the life of his enemies, or a long life for himself. Instead, he asked God to make him wise enough to judge His people.

Because he wanted the right thing, for the right reason, God gave Solomon the wisdom he asked for. He also gave him things he didn't ask for. He gave him riches, wealth, and honor like no other king of this world had before him, or will ever have after him.

God also gave Solomon the gift of discernment to know the questions in people's hearts.

He used Solomon to bring peace and security to His people in Israel. The fame of King Solomon and his special gift from God spread all throughout the land, even into the land of Sheba.
