From burly fishermen to tax collectors and treasurers, the disciples each had their own unique personalities and their own roles to play in God's great plan. They were just ordinary men who God chose to walk the earth with the greatest Man who ever lived, Jesus Christ.

NATHANAEL

A Jew without guile (John 1:47) "Before Philip called you, when you were under the fig tree..."

PHILIP

A fisherman in Bethsaida. (John 1:44) Led to preach to the Ethiopian. (Acts 8)

PETER

Andrew's Brother. He was very outspoken. He denied Jesus three times, but then got the Holy Spirit and became the spokesman on the day of Pentecost.

ANDREW

Disciple of John the Baptist (John 1:40) His brother is Simon Peter. Both are fishermen. Jesus met them on the sea of Galilee. (Mark 1:16)

JOHN

The brother of James (son of Zebedee) He was young when he was with Jesus, and lived to be an old man, even though they tried to kill him. He wrote the books of John, 1st John, 2nd John, 3rd John and Revelation.

JAMES (THE ELDER)

Brother of John (sons of thunder) He was always mentioned with John. He was killed by Herod with the sword (Acts 12:2)



SIMON (THE ZEALOT)

Zealots were a tough Jewish group that hated Roman rule.

JUDAS **ISCARIOT**

He was the treasurer and a traitor. He sold Jesus for 30 pieces of silver. Judas hung himself on a sycamore tree after he betrayed Jesus.

JAMES (THE YOUNGER)

Son of Alphaeus.
Brother to Jude.

THOMAS (ALSO DIDYMUS)


When Jesus rose, he said he wouldn't believe it until he could place his fingers in the nail prints of Jesus' hands and side.

MATTHEW

A tax collector (publican.) He was also known as Levi. Wrote the book of "Matthew"

JUDE (THADDEUS)

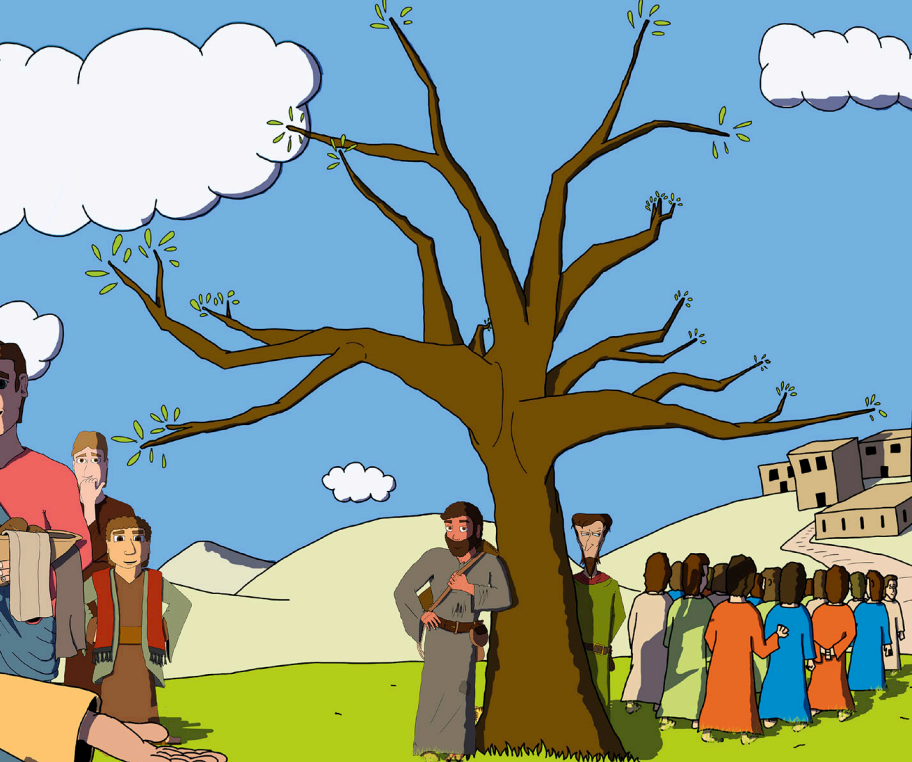
The brother of James. He wrote the book of Jude. Known by several names, like "Judas, not Iscariot"

instructions:

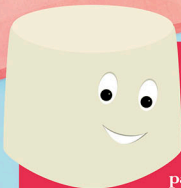

The 8-Hour Marshmallow Dessert

The Bible teaches us to be patient, so we decided to give you this recipe. If you are hungry right now, choose another dessert - but if you plan on being hungry tomorrow, this one is for you!

Ingredients

- 7 oz, sweetened shredded, toasted coconut
- Confectioners' sugar
- Homemade Marshmallow batter:
 - 3 packages of unflavored gelatin
 - 1 1/2 cups granulated sugar
 - 1 cup light corn syrup
 - 1/4 teaspoon salt
 - 1 tablespoon vanilla extract
 - Confectioners' sugar (for dusting)

FIRST, MAKE THE MARSHMALLOW BATTER:

1 Combine 3 packages of gelatin and 1/2 cup of cold water in the bowl of an electric mixer fitted with the whisk attachment and allow to sit while you make the syrup.

2 Meanwhile, combine sugar, corn syrup, salt, and 1/2 cup water in a small saucepan and cook over medium heat until the sugar dissolves. Raise the heat to high and cook until the syrup reaches 240° F on a candy thermometer. Remove from the heat.

3 With the mixer on low speed, slowly pour the sugar syrup into the dissolved gelatin. Put the mixer on high speed and whip until the mixture is very thick, about 15 minutes. Add the vanilla and mix thoroughly.

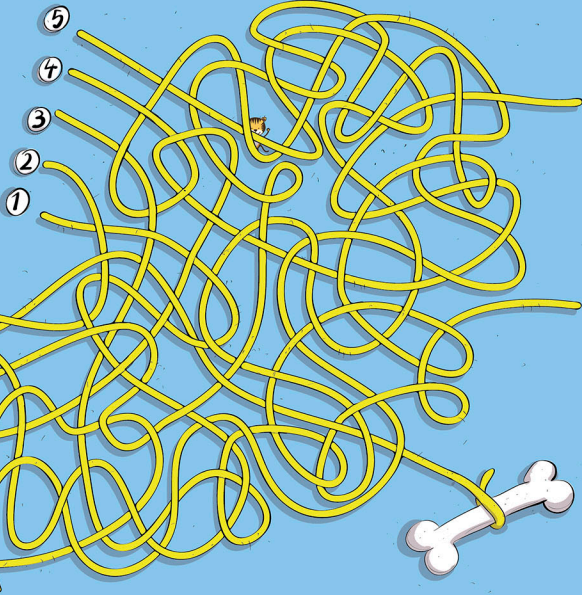
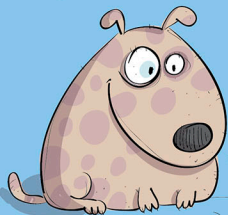
NOW PUT IT ALL TOGETHER:

4 Sprinkle half the toasted coconut into the bottom of a 8 X 12 nonmetal pan. Then, pour in the marshmallow batter on top, and smooth it out with damp hands. Sprinkle on the other half of the toasted coconut. Allow to dry uncovered at room temperature overnight.

5 The next day, remove the marshmallows from the pan and cut them into squares. Roll the sides of each piece carefully in confectioners' sugar. Eat them quickly before your dad gets home and beats you to them.

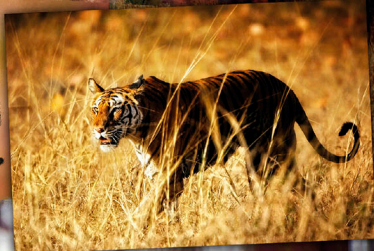

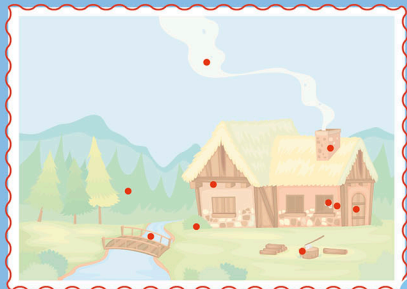
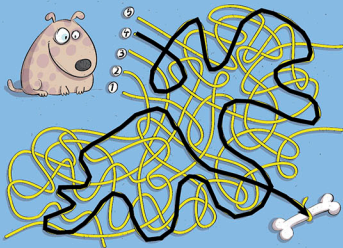
