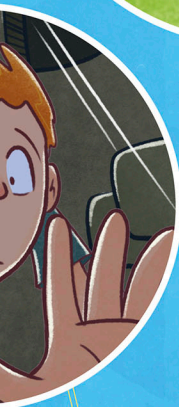

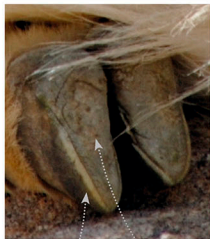


# MOUNTAIN GOATS

Brother Branham spent a lot of time hunting in the mountains, getting alone to pray. He talks about how he loves to get away in the woods, and how God is in nature. One of the animals he would hunt while out in the wilderness was the mountain goat.

Mountain goats spend most of their time high in the mountains on steep rocky cliffs. These steep ledges are dangerous with extremely rough terrain, and that is exactly why they love it! Other animals, like bears, wolverines and mountain lions, aren't as good at navigating the boulders and cliff edges as mountain goats are. This gives the mountain goat an advantage and helps them stay safe from predators.

When God made the mountain goat, He gave them hooves that were perfect for running and jumping from rock to rock.

Their hooves are what is called "cloven" which means they are split or divided, kind of like a human's toes. Under the hard-shelled hooves are soft, rough pads. When the mountain goat stands, their hooves spread apart and conform to the shape of the rocks they are on, and the rough pads are extra grippy to give them traction. Watching mountain goats jump from rock to rock, it's clear they have no fear of heights. God created them that way, and they simply trust in what He gave them.

We hope you enjoy the next few pages and learn something new about one of God's Creations: the mountain goat!

"And one of the men who knew that I loved to hunt so well, said, 'Billy, how would you like to take a hunting trip back over into the mountains after the meetings?'

I said, 'Nothing better.'

So we got twenty-one horses, and packed up, and we was eleven hundred miles from a hardtop road and about two hundred miles from the grade, with twenty-one horses, back hunting mountain goats."

**LOCATION** Mountain Goats are found on the North American continent in both Canada and the United States. They are spread throughout mountain ranges from Colorado, to Montana, Wyoming, British Columbia, and even into the southern parts of the Yukon Territory and Alaska.



## NOT A GOAT?

Though called a "goat," mountain goats are not really a goat. They are actually more closely related to antelopes, such as the impala, gazelle, and springbok!



## COUNTING ON HORNS

You can determine the age of a mountain goat by counting the rings in their horns! A mountain goat will have one less ring on its horns than its age. So a goat with two rings would be 3 years old.

## GREAT SENSES

Surviving in the wild isn't easy, but God gave mountain goats some good sight to help them. They can spot movement a mile away! So when they perch high up on a ledge, they can keep a watchful eye for danger and see it coming long before it gets close. Even if their eyes miss it, a predator would still have to get past their great sense of smell and hearing!



## STAYING WARM

The cold wind and snow doesn't bother a mountain goat. They have two layers of fur to protect them and keep them warm! The inner layer is a soft wool, like sheep have. The outer layer, called "guard hair," is longer and covers their warm, fuzzy wool.

## IN THE ROCK, I WILL HIDE

High mountains, steep cliffs and rocky bluffs might not seem like a safe place for babies, but to a mountain goat, this is a perfect nursery! Baby mountain goats, or "kids" as they are called, learn at a very early age how to jump from rock to rock. They know they

are safe from predators if they stay on the ledges and rocks. This is something the mother, called a "nannie," teaches them. Actually, mountain goats are a lot like us Christians. We know the only safe Place to be is in the Rock, Christ Jesus!



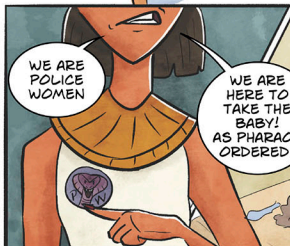
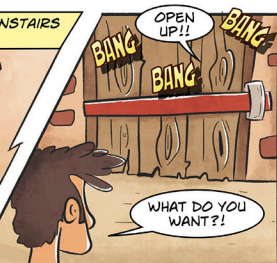
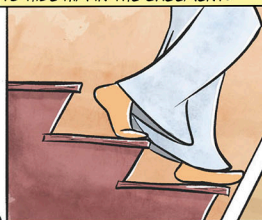




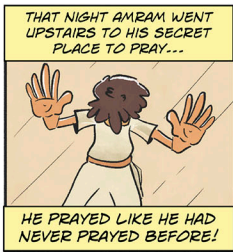
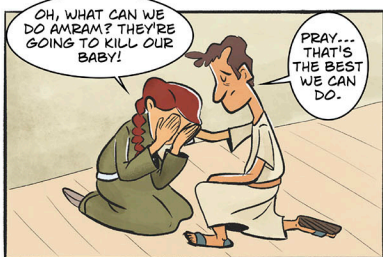




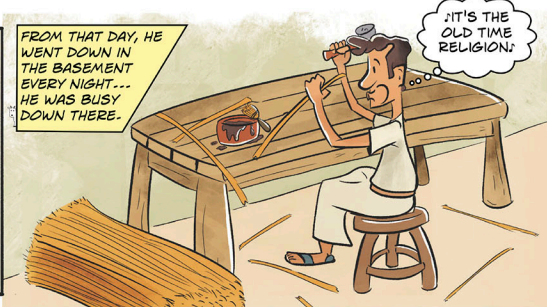

Paul chuckled and replied, "That's right, you can. Come now, Eutyclus. Let's take you back upstairs to get some food. And then we'll continue where we left off."

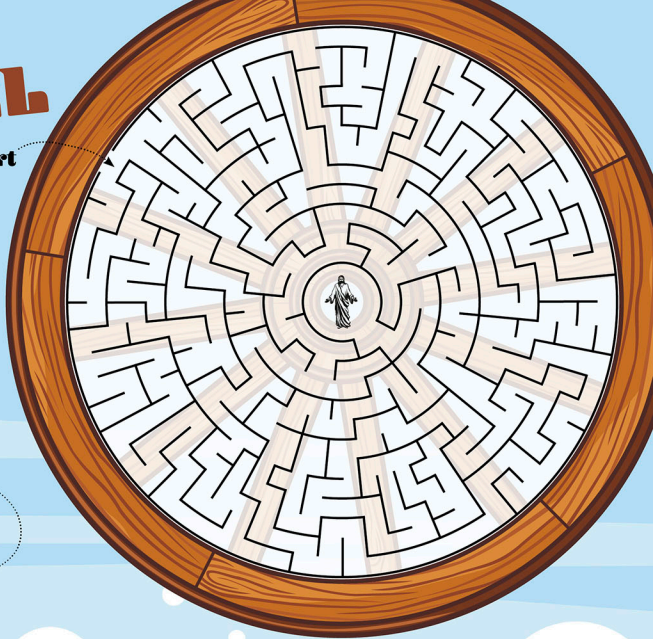

shepherd will watch over them and correct each one through the day, but when nighttime comes, the donkeys, and the camels, and the goats go out in the field, but the shepherd takes the sheep to the sheepfold.

I said, “I...Brother...I want to be a sheep, don’t you?”

And he said, “I often wondered what Saint John 10 meant, when He said, ‘I am the Door to the sheepfold.’ How could He being a Man, yet be a door?”

And I asked this good man. And he said, “You see, Brother Branham, when the sheep are taken in at night, the shepherd

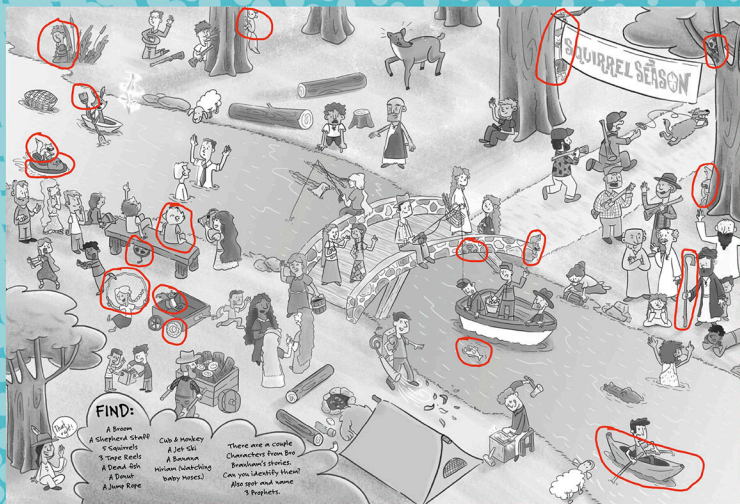

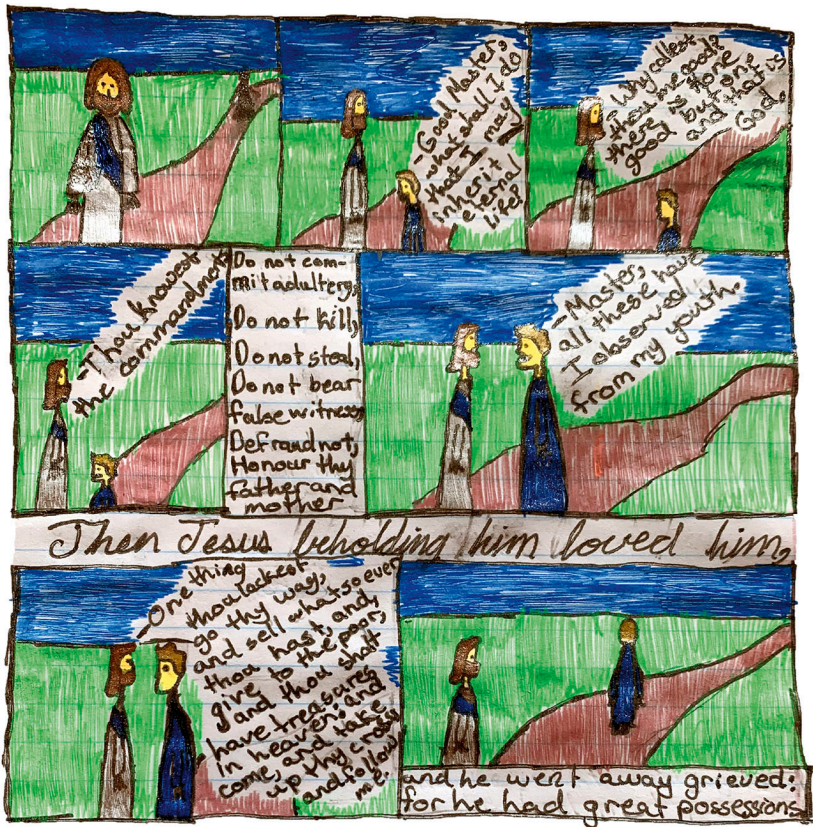
